3.3. City Hall plan for coverage when staff is out

Preliminary Plat Review for Woods Edge Subdivision located on Old Leefield Road, JAB Construction recommendation from Planning and Zoning Commission (The Planning and Zoning recommendation to the City Council is to recommend to the City Council to approve the preliminary plat review with the following conditions, no inverted crowns, all the water mains need to be the same, easement access onto private property to maintain any drainage issues, installation of sidewalks by the developer, and the radius of the cul-de-sacs need to be increased as requested.)

Preliminary Plat Review for The Orchard Subdivision located on Old Leefield Road, recommendation from Planning and Zoning (The Planning and Zoning recommendation to the City Council is to recommend to the City Council to approve the preliminary plat review with the following conditions, no inverted crown, that they provide an easement agreement with access to the drainage area(s), to protect as many trees as possible, that the builder agreement needs to include the addition of the property with the sidewalk, and the builder agrees not to pour the sidewalk over any water lines as requested.)
